CATHEDRAL ROCK



- Crowds: BUSY. You can plan on seeing other hikers in the area. In March and October, the crowds can be unmanageable.
- Hike Length: 1.5 Miles
- Difficulty: Rated difficult.
 It's a steep uphill scramble to get to the top, and you'll need use of both your hands.
- Bring: WATER, hiking shoes, backpacks.

- Lighting: Best at Sunset
- Shuttle Info: Shuttle is required Thursday - Sunday, and during Spring Break. Look at the shuttle schedule below to know where and when the shuttle leaves.

BELL ROCK



- Crowds: BUSY. There's plenty of space to spread out, but you can guarantee to see other hikers
- Hike Difficulty: With a relatively easy trail, Bell Rock offers a pleasant journey suitable for all skill levels, including families and beginners.
- Parking: Red Rock Pass Required. Plan extra time, there is limited parking and you'll most likely have to wait to park
- Lighting: Great at sunrise and sunset, although my favorite is sunrise.



- Off-road Info: Accessing Merry Go Round Rock REQUIRES a highclearance vehicle due to the rugged terrain; adventurers should come prepared for a bumpy but rewarding journey.

LOVER'S KNOLL





- Crowds: Lover's Knoll experiences a moderate level of traffic, particularly during sunset hours when couples often gather to enjoy the romantic ambiance.
- Hike Difficulty: The trail to Lover's Knoll is relatively easy, making it accessible for couples and photographers looking for a serene spot with panoramic views.
- Parking: No parking permit.
 Parking is a dirt lot next to Lover's Knoll. If you expect multiple guests, I highly recommend carpooling. Watch out for potholes!

SECRET SLICK ROCK



- Crowds: Secret Slick Rock offers a blend of tranquility and moderate activity, attracting visitors seeking a quieter alternative to more popular sites.
- Hike: 1/2 total
- Difficulty: Easy. There is a steep part at the end so heels are not recommended.
- Lighting: Sunrise and sunset are equally gorgeous.

Parking: No pass required.
 Although parking spaces may be limited, visitors to Secret Slick Rock generally find sufficient parking options available, allowing for a hassle-free experience amidst Sedona's natural beauty.
